

	Emergency?	When should I call?	Common Problems
<i>Cough</i>	No	Between 8AM-5PM	Allergies, Pneumonia
<i>Cut on Leg</i>	Maybe	Immediately	A minor wound can lead to life threatening infections.
<i>Cut on the body</i>	Maybe	Immediately	A tetanus booster or antitoxin should be given anytime a horse is cut
<i>Diarrhea</i>	No	Between 8AM-5PM	Infection, Change in Feed, and many others
<i>Difficult breathing</i>	Maybe	Immediately	Strangles, Pneumonia, or Allergies
<i>Lots of green fluid coming out the horse's nose</i>	Yes	Immediately	Choke
<i>Mild Lameness</i>	no	Between 8AM-5PM	Arthritis, Pulled Tendon
<i>Pawing, rolling, looking back at flank</i>	Yes	Immediately	Colic
<i>Swollen under jaw</i>	No	Between 8AM-5PM	Strangles (Distemper)
<i>Very lame leg</i>	Maybe	Immediately	Hoof Abscess or Broken Bone
